IF YOU HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED that someone will request that a Sonoma County Superior Court Judicial Officer grant temporary orders against you, you have a right to submit an opposition or response to the request for temporary orders. Complete the other side of this form and deliver the original to the Sonoma County Superior Court, Family Law Division, 3055 Cleveland Avenue, Santa Rosa, CA 95403 no later than 8:30 am (Domestic Violence) or 10:00 am (All Other Ex-Parte/Emergency Requests) on the day the judge will review the request for temporary orders. The Family Law Division is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm. Make sure you have the full name of both parties on the document so we can match it to the correct request for temporary orders. You must provide a copy of your opposition to the other party.

The date the Judicial Officer will review the request for temporary orders is listed on the Declaration Regarding Notice of Request for Temporary Orders. Look for the line: The Judicial Officer will be asked to consider the request for temporary orders on (Date). YOUR OPPOSITION MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN 8:30 AM (Domestic Violence) or 10:00 AM (All Other Ex-Parte/Emergency Requests) ON THE DATE LISTED.

The date a Judicial Officer will review the request for temporary orders is not a court date. The Judicial Officer considers the request for temporary orders based on written documents only. If you are required to appear at a court hearing, you will be notified.
