This Addendum is provided to all potential proposers in the Mental Health Services RFP.

Question 1

About how many cases do you imagine would one get monthly?

Answer 1

As indicated in the RFP, Sonoma Court performs approximately 400 competency evaluations a year. The monthly case load per service provider would be dependent on the number of qualified mental health providers on the panel and the capacity each provider can accommodate. Additionally, based on the needs of the individual being assessed, some providers with more expertise in certain mental health areas may be recommended.

Question 2

As I am in Southern California, I would have to use telepsychiatry for the eval. The RFP said that it would consider. Is that a strong possibility or a mere "consideration?"

Answer 2

As indicated in the RFP, Sonoma Court may explore the use of Telepsychiatry to conduct mental health evaluations during the life of the Master Agreement, dependent on the availability of service providers. All potential proposers are encouraged to submit a proposal so the Court will be prepared to move forward with Telepsychiatry when/if the Court is ready to receive such services.

Question 3

Can the evaluations be done on weekends or weekdays only?

Answer 3

Evaluations may be done on the weekends as determined by the jail schedule.

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
