NOTICE OF RESETTING CRIMINAL HEARINGS ORIGINALLY CALENDARED
BETWEEN OCTOBER 10 AND OCTOBER 20

The recent Sonoma County wild fires significantly impacted the court's facilities and inhibited the court's ability to conduct business and open to the public from October 10, 2017 through October 20, 2017. If you had a scheduled hearing in the criminal division between those dates your hearing is being reset to a later date. Notice of the new hearing date is being mailed to you and your attorney.

If you had a court date which fell between October 10th through October 20th and you do not receive a Notice Resetting Hearing by November 10th; immediately contact your attorney and ask them to place your case on calendar. If you do not have an attorney and do not receive a Notice Re- Setting Hearing by November 10th, contact the criminal clerk's office at 707-521-6620, between the hours of 8:00 am and 12:00 noon.

When contacting your attorney, or the criminal clerk's office, please identify yourself with a full true and correct name and date of birth. You will be provided with a court date. You must appear on the court date you receive, or you must contact the clerk's office and reschedule a different date.

If you have bailed to appear, contact your bail bondsman and they can assist you in obtaining your new hearing date or placing your case on calendar.

A warrant for your arrest may issue for non-appearances.
