Petitions for Ex Parte Orders re: Workplace Violence are reviewed by a judge each morning between 8:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. If you would like the judge to review your forms the day you drop them off, you must be here between 8:00 a.m. and 8:25 a.m. Forms which are received in the Clerks Office after 8:25 a.m. will be submitted to the Judge for review on the next court business day. Your copies of the signed orders may be picked up in Room 107-J after 2:00 p.m. and before 3:00 p.m.

Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 527 you may be required to pay a fee for filing a Petition Prohibiting Violence or Threats of Violence against an Employee (Workplace Violence) if there has been no violence or threat of violence.

Please note: These forms can be used only by an **employer** of a person who is suffering unlawful violence or a credible threat of violence. If anyone other than the employer wishes to apply to the court for an order prohibiting harassment, see the Judicial Council's *Instructions for Lawsuits to Prohibit Harassment (form CH-150).*
