- 1. Complete the following forms:
 - CV-30 Declaration Re: Civil Warrant
 - CV-31 Civil Bench Warrant
- 2. Submit to Clerk:
 - Original and 2 copies of the Civil Bench Warrant (CV-31)
 - Original and 2 copies of the Declaration Re: Civil Warrant (CV-30)
 - A self-addressed stamped envelope for return of the forms or provide your attorney box number on the forms.
- Clerk will return endorsed filed copies of the Declaration Re: Civil Warrant to you and a copy of the Civil Bench Warrant. THE CLERK WILL HOLD THE ORIGINAL CIVIL BENCH WARRANT and will <u>not</u> forward it to the Sheriff until you comply with Step 4 listed below.

IMPORTANT NEXT STEPS

4. The Sheriff MUST receive <u>signed</u> instructions from you before they will serve a Civil Warrant. Once you receive your declaration and copy of the civil warrant that has been signed by the judicial officer:

Complete the Sheriff Instruction Sheet (Sheriff's form number CIV-208).

Submit the form to the Sheriff Civil Division located at 2796 Ventura Avenue, Santa Rosa, CA 95403 (Telephone: 565-2751).

The Sheriff charges a fee for this process. The fee varies between depending on the type of warrant served.

- 5. Once the Sheriff receives your instructions, they will request the original civil warrant from the Clerk and start the process of service of the warrant.
- 6. All parties must appear at the hearing or matter will be dropped.
