21	(a) Purpose
22	Notwithstanding any other law, this rule establishes an Emergency Bail Schedule,
23	which is intended to promulgate uniformity in the handling of certain offenses during
24	the state of emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic in the County of Sonoma.
25	() More later combination
26	(b) Mandatory application This bail schedule shall apply:
27	(1) To every accused person arrested and in pretrial custody.
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- 1 - BAIL SCHEDULE

(2) To every accused person held in pretrial custody.

(c) Setting of bail and exceptions

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Under this Emergency Bail Schedule, bail for all misdemeanor and felony offenses shall be set at \$0, with the exception of only the offenses listed below:

- <u>A serious felony, as defined in Penal Code section 192.7(c), or a violent</u>
 <u>felony, as defined in Penal Code section 667.5(c);</u>
- (2) A felony violation of Penal Code section 69;
- (3) A violation of Penal Code section 166(c)(1);
- (4) <u>A violation of Penal Code section 136.1 when punishment is imposed under</u> section 136.1(c);
- (5) <u>A violation of Penal Code section 262;</u>
- (6) <u>A violation of Penal Code sections 243(e)(1) or 273.5;</u>
- (7) <u>A violation of Penal Code section 273.6 if the detained person made threats to kill or harm, has engaged in violence against, or has gone to the residence or workplace of, the protected party;</u>
- (8) A violation of Penal Code section 422 where the offense is punished as a felony;
- (9) <u>A violation of Penal Code section 646.9;</u>
- (10) <u>A violation of an offense listed in Penal Code section 290(c);</u>
- (11) A violation of Vehicle Code sections 23152 or 23153;
- (12) A felony violation of Penal Code section 463; and
- (13) A violation of Penal Code section 29800.

(d) Ability to deny bail

Nothing in the Emergency Bail Schedule restricts the ability of the court to deny bail as authorized by article I, section 12, or 28(f)(3) of the California Constitution.

 court-specific conduct enhancements and any status enhancements. (2) This court retains the authority to reduce the amount of bail listed in the concountywide bail schedule in effect on March 15, 2020, for offenses in exceptions (1) through (13), or for any offenses not in conflict with the Emergency Bail Schedule. (3) If a person was released on or after April 6, 2020, on reduced bail pursuant Emergency Rule 4 of the Judicial Council of California, or by agreement between the Sonoma County District Attorney and defense counsel on pret supervision terms and conditions, and that person is arrested for a new offer violation of probation, or violation of supervision terms, bail shall be set pursuant to the countywide bail schedule of the Sonoma County Superior C that was in effect on March 15, 2020. (1) Under this Emergency Bail Schedule, bail for all violations of misdemeanor probation, whether the arrest is with or without a bench warrant, shall be set \$0. (2) Bail for all violations of felony probation, parole, post-release community supervision, or mandatory supervision, shall be set in accord with this Emergency Bail Schedule, or for the bail amount in the court's countywide schedule of bail for charges of conviction listed in exceptions (1) through (1) throu		in effect on March 15, 2020, shall remain in effect for all offenses listed in
