Once you are accepted into our MHD program, please ask about some of the resources and benefits the program can offer you to help you succeed:

<u>Mental Health Medication</u>	<u>Therapy</u>	<u>Transportation</u>	<u>Housing</u>
The court can reimburse you for out-of-pocket costs and co-pays or refer you to a court-contracted pharmacy to cover the cost of medication.	The court can refer you to no-cost therapists available for both in-person or telehealth treatment. You may also qualify for cost reimbursement related to your current therapist.	The court can provide city and county bus passes or can reimburse you for Uber/Lyft/Taxi rides to treatment court, treatment appointments, and other court-ordered treatment (e.g.: anger mgmt.).	The court has compiled a housing guide and can assist you in navigating the process of finding housing.
