

2025 CRIMINAL BAIL SCHEDULE

Adopted June 24, 2025 pursuant to Penal Code sections 1269b.(c) and 1269b.(d)

Pre-Arraignment Release Protocol

The purpose of bail is to ensure an arrestee appears for all court appearances and reduce the risk to public or victim safety. (Cal. Const.,art.1 §28 (f)(3).) Arrestees, presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt, are entitled to release on bail while awaiting trial. Individuals charged with crimes listed in Penal Code §1270.1 are not eligible for pre-arraignment supervised release consideration and bail will be set pursuant to the attached schedule until further review at the time of arraignment. The Constitution prohibits excessive bail and requires that judicial officers take into account the protection of the public, safety of the victim, seriousness of the offense charged, previous criminal record of the arrestee, and the probability of the arrestee appearing at court appearances.

Consistent with these purposes, the Sonoma County Superior Court adopted a Pretrial Release Program in 2015 to evaluate eligible arrestees for release on Pretrial Release Supervision at the time of arraignment. In July, 2020, the Sonoma County Superior Court became one of only 16 courts to offer Pre-Arraignment Release Supervision under the Pretrial Pilot Program overseen by the Judicial Council of California.

Currently, the Sonoma County Superior Court operates a Pre-Arraignment Release Program in which pretrial assessments are conducted and reviewed seven days a week, from 6:00a.m. to approximately 8:00p.m. This significantly reduces the potential time an arrestee spends in custody, especially for those arrested on a Friday or over the weekend, and compared to those who are released on monetary bail. All individuals booked into the Main Adult Detention Facility are screened for Pre-Trial Release eligibility. Probation also performs assessments on most arrestees prior to booking. Assessments of individuals that are eligible for PSP services are electronically forwarded to designated Court Commissioners to review and make pre-arraignment release decisions.

If pre-arraignment release is denied, bail is set pursuant to the attached schedule, and the next pre-trial release decision will occur at arraignment. If pre-arraignment release is granted, the Court Commissioner will determine at what level of monitoring the individual will be released, and based on that level, what specific terms will be included.

Further, in collaboration with Sonoma County Behavioral Health, the Court may offer individuals with mental health challenges pre-trial release under the JMHCP program.

Judicial Considerations

The following schedule is the presumptive bail for many but not all the statutory crimes for the State of California. At first appearances and arraignments in court, the judicial officer may exercise discretion to lower or raise bail based on the actual charges filed by the District Attorney, enhancements and prior convictions alleged, and prior strikes filed. A judicial officer may review the schedule for an individual case and exercise discretion in setting bail either above or below the presumptive amount. In doing so, the judicial officer shall consider the factors in Penal Code section 1275 such as the protection of the public, the seriousness of the charged crimes, the previous criminal record of the defendant and the probability the defendant will appear in court. Public safety is the primary consideration in accordance with Penal Code § 1275 (a)(1). The judicial officer shall also take into consideration defendant's ability to pay, as well as, other individualized factors bearing upon his/her dangerousness and/or risk of flight and will consider whether less restrictive means to bail are appropriate in accordance with *In re Humphrey*, 19 Cal.App.5th 1006.

Arrests for More Than One Crime

Arresting agencies and detention facilities are directed to follow the below guidelines when booking persons for more than one crime and/or warrants.

- 1. When a defendant is booked for, or charged with, two or more offenses, bail shall be the amount computed under this schedule for the charge having the highest bail, including applicable amounts for enhancements and prior convictions.
- 2. When a person is booked on two or more crimes that are listed as violent felonies in <u>Penal Code Section 667.5(c)</u>, the bail amounts shall be stacked and added together. Amounts for enhancements and prior convictions shall be added one time per defendant or case
- 3. When a person is booked on a crime or crimes and has outstanding warrants, the warrant amounts shall be stacked in addition to the schedule bail amounts for the new crime or crimes
- 4. When a person is booked on two or more crimes, whether the crimes are misdemeanors or felonies, bail will be added together and stacked if:
 - a. The crimes are committed against separate victims or on separate dates, or;
 - b. Where separate sex acts are committed on the same victim and each may be punished separately.

Note to Law Enforcement:

Questions concerning the application of this bail schedule to any particular arrestee may be made to the Supervising Judge of the Criminal Division or his or her designee during the work week. After work hours, the ON CALL DUTY judge is available through the Sonoma County Sheriff's Office Dispatch via the ON CALL DUTY cell phone number.

OFFENSES NOT SPECIFIED, VOPs & PTR VIOLATIONS

MISDEMEANORS

OFFENSES WITH NO SPECIFIED PRESUMPTIVE BAIL LISTED IN THE ATTACHED SCHEDULE:

PRE-ARRAIGNMENT: If no presumptive bail is specified, the pre-arraignment presumptive bail for misdemeanors shall be \$0, up to the time of arraignment.

If defendant is out on bail, own recognizance or PTR and is subsequently arrested on a new misdemeanor, the presumptive bail on **the new misdemeanor is \$1000** (even if the new offense is an otherwise \$0 bail qualifying offense) **or the scheduled bail amount,** whichever is higher.

AT ARRAIGNMENT: \$0 bail will be presumed to exonerate, and PTR will become presumptive. For all crimes, judicial officers maintain

the discretion to adjust the bail amount as they deem appropriate.

FAILURE TO APPEAR: If defendant has been released on \$0 bail, and subsequently fails to appear in court as directed, bail will no longer be

presumed to be \$0 and the bench warrant amount will be set at the discretion of the judicial officer. At the next court

appearance, the judicial officer may utilize their discretion in resetting bail or placing defendant on PTR.

VIOLATIONS OF MISDEMEANOR PROBATION ON ZERO DOLLAR BAIL OFFENSES: \$1,000

VIOLATIONS ON MISDEMEANOR PROBATION WHERE PRESUMPTIVE BAIL IS SPECFIED: 2X Presumptive Bail Amount

VIOLATIONS OF PTR ON ALL MISDEMEANORS OFFENSES: \$2,500 or presumptive amount, whichever is

higher

FELONIES

OFFENSES WITH NO SPECIFIED PRESUMPTIVE BAIL LISTED IN THE ATTACHED SCHEDULE:

PRE-ARRAIGNMENT: If no presumptive bail is specified, the pre-arraignment presumptive bail for felonies shall be \$0, up to the time of arraignment, UNLESS any enhancement or special allegation is alleged. If any enhancement or special allegation is alleged, see enhancement within attached schedule for presumptive bail amount. If no amount is specified, the default amount is \$25,000.

> If defendant is out on bail, own recognizance or PTR and is subsequently arrested on a new felony, the presumptive bail on the new felony is \$10,000 (even if the new offense is an otherwise \$0 bail offense) or the scheduled bail amount, whichever is higher.

AT ARRAIGNMENT: \$0 bail will be presumed to exonerate, and PTR will become presumptive. For all crimes, judicial officers maintain the discretion to adjust the bail amount as they deem appropriate.

FAILURE TO APPEAR: If defendant has been released on \$0 bail, and subsequently fails to appear in court as directed, bail will no longer be presumed to be \$0 and the bench warrant amount will be set at the discretion of the judicial officer. At the next court appearance, the judicial officer may utilize their discretion in resetting bail or placing defendant on PTR.
