## **Investigative Review Guidelines**

Communications from the public can provide valuable information to the Civil Grand Jury. Any private county resident, government employee, or officer may submit a completed review form to request that the Civil Grand Jury conduct an investigation. This review must be in writing and is treated as confidential. Prior to submitting the Request for Investigative Review form to the Grand Jury office, please retain a copy for your records if needed. Receipt of all review requests will be acknowledged. Exhibits or supporting documents attached to this request become property of the Grand Jury and will not be returned.

- If the Civil Grand Jury determines that a matter is within the legally permissible scope of its investigative powers and would warrant further inquiry, additional information may be requested.
- If a matter does not fall within the Civil Grand Jury's investigative authority, or the jury determines not to investigate, no action will be taken.

The findings of any investigation conducted by the Civil Grand Jury can be communicated only in a formal final report published at the conclusion of the Grand Jury's term, June 30th.

The jurisdiction of the Civil Grand Jury includes the following:

- Misconduct or wrongdoing in their official capacities by officials or employees of the County of Sonoma, cities, school districts, or special districts, such as water, sewer etc. within Sonoma County.
- Inquiry into the condition and management of the jails within the county.
- Investigation and report on the operations, accounts, and records of the officers, departments or
  functions of the county including those operations, accounts, and records of any special
  legislative district or other district in the county created pursuant to state law for which the officers
  of the county are serving in their ex officio capacity as officers of the districts.
- Investigation of the books and records of any incorporated city or joint powers agency located in the county.
- Failure of the County of Sonoma, a city, or special district to provide essential public services.
