### **1. 25CV03136, Capital One v Struthers Jr.**

Plaintiff Capital One, N.A.’s motion for summary judgment is **CONTINUED to Wednesday, April 1, 2026 at 3:00 p.m.** in Department 18. On January 29, 2026, Plaintiff filed an amended notice of hearing on its motion for summary judgment informing Defendant, who is self-represented, of the corrected hearing date of February 13, 2026. This was not sufficient notice for Defendant to timely oppose the motion at least 20 days before the hearing as required by C.C.P. section 437c(b)(2). Any opposition shall be due at least 20 days before the April 1, 2026, hearing date in compliance with section 437c(b)(2).
