1. **PETITION OF CORY LACEY** **25CV06960**

TENTATIVE RULING: No Appearance is Required. The Court finds that Petitioner Cory Lacey, a/k/a "Cory Michael Lacy", has complied with all prerequisites outlined under California Code of Civil procedure ("C.C.P.") §1276 et. seq. for a Petition for Change of Name. The Court finds that no timely objection has been filed against said Petition. Therefore, the Court now GRANTS the Petitioner's Decree Changing Name of "Cory Lacey", a/k/a "Cory Michael Lacey" to "Cole Jameson Lacey".

2. **PETITION OF CONFIDENTIAL 1** **25CV08726**

TENTATIVE RULING: No Appearance is Required.
