**1. Guardianship of Molly Yvonne Eleanor Matute

Appointment of Guardian**

TENTATIVE RULING:

APPEARANCES ARE REQUIRED. The petitioner has not lodged any additional or updated information with the court regarding the status of a preexisting guardianship of the subject minor in another jurisdiction. The proceedings in the instant case have been continued for more than a year to allow the petitioner opportunity to clarify and remedy the impediment of a preexisting guardianship to no end. The petitioner is to appear and update the court on the status of the guardianship in San Joaquin County or show cause why the court should not finally deny this petition for guardianship of the minor.
