1. 25CV00413, LoanDepot.com, LLC v. Hernandez

Defendant Ismael Hernandez moves to consolidate case no. 25CV06874 with the instant case 25CV00413. The motion is **DROPPED as MOOT** as both cases have been adjudicated. The Court granted Plaintiff’s motion for summary judgment in the instant case on May 13, 2026. (See Notice of Ruling on Plaintiff’s Motion for Summary Judgment, filed on May 29, 2026.)

2-3. 25CV04882, Moreno v. Merino Mendez

Plaintiffs’ counsel, Johann Hall, seeks to be relieved as counsel for Plaintiffs Anita and Armand Moreno in separate motions. However, on April 16, 2026, both Plaintiffs filed Form MC-050 for Substitution of Attorney substituting in new counsel. The motions to be relieved as counsel are **DENIED as MOOT**.
