1. Guardianship of Camilla Ashley Saenz

Review Re Visitation

TENTATIVE RULING:

Appearances ARE required. The parties are to appear and provide the Court with an update on visitation. Absent objection, the Court is prepared to grant Mother's request for two hours of unsupervised visitation each week as outlined in her declaration.

2. Guardianship of Landon Archie Heath, LaMichael Van Heath, and Drevon Melton

TENTATIVE RULING:

Appearances ARE required. The parties are to appear and provide the Court with an update on visitation, and whether court involvement remains necessary. If the parties have been unable to informally resolve the matter, the Court will set a date for a contested hearing on the issue, with an order for the parties to exchange witness lists and any documents they anticipate using at the hearing, providing the same to the Court, at least two weeks prior to the contested hearing. The parties shall review Local Rules 6.2F which requires, among other things, that parties meet and confer for purposes of making reasonable efforts to informally resolve any controversies and to file Statements of Issues or Settlement prior to an evidentiary hearing.

TENTATIVE RULING:

Appearances are NOT required. Absent objection, the Petition for Guardianship is GRANTED and the Court will sign the proposed order submitted by Petitioner(s).

Petitioner/Guardian is directed to file the Confidential Guardianship Status Report, GC-251, within one year and 30 days from the date of the order granting the Petition for Guardianship, and annually thereafter. (Form GC-251 is available at the following URL: <https://www.courts.ca.gov/forms.htm>) To ensure compliance with the requirement of an annual GC-251, this matter is set for Case Management Conference at 9:00 a.m. on October 5, 2027__, in Department 61. If the Guardian has at that time filed the required GC-251, an appearance will be waived and a new hearing date shall be set for one year out for the filing of the annual Status Report.

Further advisements which are not part of tentative ruling: If any objections are filed at or before the time of hearing, the Court will not adopt the tentative ruling and will, instead, set the matter for a contested hearing and the parties will be notified by the Court as to when they should next appear.

Absent objection, the Request for Special Immigrant Juvenile Findings is GRANTED and the Court will sign the proposed order submitted by Petitioner.

The ward will attain the age of 21 on January 17, 2028, at which time the guardianship will terminate by operation of law. The case is set on February 1, 2028, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 61, to address termination of the guardianship and dismissal of the case. No appearances will be required.

TENTATIVE RULING:

Appearances are NOT required. The petition for guardianship is DENIED. The proper venue for initiation of Probate Guardianship of the Person is the county of residence where the proposed ward lives, or any other county that is in the best interest of the proposed ward. CA Prob C 2201. When the proposed ward does not reside in California, the proper venue to initiate Probate Guardianship of the Person is the county where the proposed ward is temporarily living, or any other county that is in the best interest of the proposed ward. CA Prob C 2202. According to the petition in this case, the proposed ward already resides in the state of Georgia, and the proposed ward and proposed guardians intend to remain in the state of Georgia for the foreseeable future. Accordingly, there is no proper venue in the state of California to initiate Probate Guardianship of the Person. Petitioners' relief is instead properly sought through the courts in the state of Georgia.

TENTATIVE RULING:

Appearances are NOT required. Absent objection, the Petition for Guardianship is GRANTED and the Court will sign the proposed order submitted by Petitioner(s). The Court finds good cause to waive and does waive further investigation if any is required under Prob. Code § 1513.

Absent objection, the Request for Special Immigrant Juvenile Findings is GRANTED and the Court will sign the proposed order submitted by Petitioner.

The ward will attain the age of 21 on October 11, 2028, at which time the guardianship will terminate by operation of law. The case is set on November 7, 2028, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 61, to address termination of the guardianship and dismissal of the case. No appearances will be required.
