Civil and Family Law Courthouse – Courtroom Audio Visual Abbreviated Flip Top Media Center Instructions for Attorneys and Litigants

Courtroom Counsel Table Audio Visual Media Center

A Crestron QM-FTMC Flip Top Media Center is located on each of the counsel tables in each courtroom (see photos). Available connections for use by attorneys and litigants include:

- 1. Laptop VGA
- 2. 3.5mm Stereo Audio Jack
- 3. S-Video
- 4. Composite Video
- 5. AC Power



- 1. Connect laptop to COMPUTER jack (VGA cable)
- 2. Connect laptop audio to AUDIO jack (3.5mm Stereo Audio)
- 3. Set laptop to "monitor mode" or "mirror monitor mode" (i.e. Fn, F5)
- 4. Set laptop to 1024x768 screen resolution (Control Panel/Display Settings)
- 5. Courtroom staff will activate video projection from AV touch panel control

Connect Video Equipment/Document Projector/etc.

- 1. Connect video equipment by connecting S Video or composite video cables to S-VIDEO or VIDEO jacks
- 2. When connected, courtroom staff will activate the audio and video using the courtroom AV touch panel controller

Connect "Audio Only" (i.e. Mp3 player, CD player, etc.)

- 1. Connect audio source to AUDIO on media center (3.5mm)
- 2. Or ... connect audio source to the red and white S VIDEO or VIDEO connections using audio cables with RCA (male) connectors
- 3. When connected, inform courtroom staff they will activate the connection (if needed)
